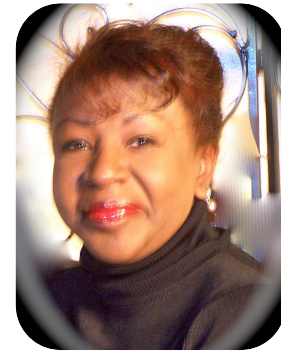

Romans 12:18 says, “If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.”

Talking about love at Christmas time is very important, and what a wonderful time of the year to reach out to those all around you! Jesus is that love letter written in flesh to the whole world. John 3:16 says “...
